SubZero awarded \$5.9 million Infrastructure & Poly contract

SubZero Group's Infrastructure and Poly division has signed a \$5.9 million contract with BHP Billiton to upgrade part of the water network at the Mt Arthur Coal mine.

The project is part of the decommissioning of the main dam water network at Mt Arthur Coal. SubZero's scope of work includes supply and installation of 25kms of poly pipe and relocating pumps and pontoons and all associated earthworks. The works began on Wednesday 10 April 2013.
