Summary for the Quarter Ended 30 June 2023

Fatfish Group Ltd ("**Fatfish**" or the "**Company**") is pleased to provide the quarterly summary of its activities for the quarter ended 30 June 2023 ("**Quarter**").

During the Quarter, Fatfish recorded a slightly lower cash receipt of A\$1.00 million, down from A\$1.28 million in the previous quarter. This was mainly due to the fact that the management had been actively refining revenue streams to achieve higher quality revenue for its fintech business in order to move its fintech business to a stage where it could get closer to profitability.

During the Quarter, Fatfish had raised a total of A\$1.3 million in new capital via a private placement that was entirely taken up by a strategic Asian institutional investor. The A\$1.3 million was raised through the issuance of 51,818,994 ordinary shares in the Company at an issue price of AUD\$0.025 per Placement Share, pursuant to the Company's placement capacity under ASX Listing Rule 7.1.

The capital raised was used for general working capital, and the development and expansion of the Company's fintech business, mainly operated through its subsidiary, ASEAN Fintech Group Ltd.



The Company entered into a definitive legally binding agreement with US based Arena Investors, LP for the iussuance of up to \$8 millior convertible notes. Salient terms of the Notes are as follows:

(i) To be drawn 1 tranche;

(ii) Investor may elect to convert the Notes at any time up to the Maturity Date, at a conversion price of \$0.07 per Note.

(iii) Maturity date is 12 months from date of issue of the tranche, which shall be extendable upon mutual agreement of the parties, after which the Company shall redeem the relevant Notes in cash, provided that they have not been converted into shares by the Investor; and

(iv) Coupon rate of 1.0% per annum.
