## **Business**

#### **Financial statements and Reports**

To receive and consider the Company's financial statements, Directors' Report and Auditor's Report for the financial year ended 31 December 2023.

**Note:** There is no requirement for shareholders to approve these reports.

#### **Resolution 1: Adoption of Remuneration Report**

To consider, and if thought fit, to pass the following resolution as an **ordinary resolution**:

"That in accordance with Section 250R of the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth), the Remuneration Report, as set out in the Directors' Report, be adopted."

#### Notes

- a) the vote on this resolution is advisory only and does not bind the Directors or the Company.
- the Company's key management personnel (whose remuneration details are included in the Remuneration Report) and their closely related parties must not cast a vote on the Remuneration Report unless they are appointed in writing as a proxy for a member eligible to vote on the resolution, and that proxy specifies how to vote on the resolution or the vote is cast by the Chair as proxy for a member eligible to vote on the resolution, the proxy does not specify how to vote on the resolution and the proxy expressly authorises the Chair to vote even if it is connected with the remuneration of a member of the key management personnel.
- c) The Chair will vote all undirected proxies in favour of this resolution. If you wish to vote "against" or "abstain" you should mark the

relevant box in the attached proxy and question form

#### Resolution 2: Election of Director - Dr Philip Lowe

To consider, and if thought fit, to pass the following resolution as an **ordinary resolution**:

"That Dr Philip Lowe, having been appointed as a Director of the Company on 12 March 2024, be elected in accordance with Rule 35(a) and 35(b) of the Company's Constitution."

Directors appointed under Rule 35(a) and 35(b) of the Company's Constitution must retire at the first AGM after their appointment, where they are eligible to be elected by shareholders. Dr Lowe is retiring under this rule.

Information about Dr Lowe appears in the Explanatory Memorandum attached to this Notice of Meeting.

## Resolution 3: Re-election of Director - David Paradice AO

To consider, and if thought fit, to pass the following resolution as an **ordinary resolution**:

"That Mr David Paradice AO, who retires by rotation in accordance with Rule 35(c) of the Company's Constitution and Listing Rule 14.4 and, being eligible and offering himself for re-election, be re-elected as a Director of the Company."

Information about Mr Paradice appears in the Explanatory Memorandum attached to this Notice of Meeting.



## Resolution 4: Re-election of Director - Kate Thorley

To consider, and if thought fit, to pass the following resolution as an **ordinary resolution**:

"That Ms Kate Thorley, who retires by rotation in accordance with Rule 35(c) of the Company's Constitution and Listing Rule 14.4 and, being eligible and offering herself for re-election, be re-elected as a Director of the Company."

Information about Ms Thorley appears in the Explanatory Memorandum attached to this Notice of Meeting.

#### Other business

To consider any other business that may lawfully be brought forward in accordance with the constitution of the Company or the law.

#### Voting exclusions – Resolution 1

Resolution 1 is indirectly connected with the remuneration of members of the key management personnel of the Company (KMP Members). In accordance with the requirements of the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth) (Corporations Act) the Company will disregard any votes cast (in any capacity) on Resolution 1 by or on behalf of:

- a KMP Member other than the Chair; and
- a closely related party of those persons (such as close family members and any companies the person controls), unless the vote is cast as proxy for a person entitled to vote in accordance with a direction on the proxy and question form.

In regard to votes cast by the Chair as proxy for a person entitled to vote in accordance with a direction on the proxy and question form, the Company will not disregard such votes by the Chair provided that the appointment expressly authorises the Chair to exercise the proxy even though the Resolution is connected directly or indirectly with the remuneration of a KMP Member.

What this means for Shareholders: if you intend to appoint a KMP Member (such as one of the Directors) as your proxy, please ensure that you direct them how to vote on Resolution 1. If you appoint the Chair as your proxy, and you do not direct your proxy how to vote on Resolution 1 on the proxy and question form, you will be expressly authorising the Chair of the Meeting to exercise the proxy even if the resolution is connected, directly or indirectly, with the remuneration of the KMP which includes the Chair. The Chair of the Meeting intends to vote undirected proxies in favour of Resolution 1.

#### Other information

An Explanatory Memorandum accompanies and forms part of this Notice of Meeting. All Shareholders should read the Explanatory Memorandum carefully and in its entirety. Shareholders who are in doubt regarding any part of the business of the Meeting should consult their financial or legal adviser for assistance.

#### **Proxies**

A member entitled to attend and vote at this AGM is entitled to appoint not more than two proxies to attend and vote in his/her place. A proxy does not need to be a member of the Company.

If a member appoints two proxies, the member may specify the proportion or number of votes each proxy is entitled to exercise. If no proportion or number of votes is specified, each proxy may exercise half of the member's votes. If the specified proportion or number of votes exceeds that which the member is entitled to, each proxy may exercise half of the member's votes. Any fractions of votes brought about by the apportionment of votes to a proxy will be disregarded.

Proxies can be appointed in one of three ways:

- b) by posting or delivering the proxy and question form by hand to the share registry (addresses below); or

In accordance with section 1074E(2)(g)(i) of the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth) and regulation 7.11.37 of the Corporations Regulations 2001 (Cth), the Company has determined that for the purposes of the meeting all shares in the capital of the Company will be taken to be held by the persons who held them as registered holders at 7:00pm (AEST) on Sunday 5 May 2024. Accordingly, share transfers registered after that time will be disregarded in determining entitlements to attend and vote at the AGM.

## **Explanatory Memorandum**

This Explanatory Memorandum sets out further information regarding the proposed resolutions to be considered by Shareholders of Future Generation Australia Limited (the Company) at the 2024 Annual General Meeting (AGM) to be held at 11:00am (AEST) on Tuesday 7 May 2024 at Museum of Sydney, Warrane Theatre Corner of Bridge Street & Phillip Street, Sydney NSW 2000 and online via https://web.lumiagm.com/318819482.

The Directors recommend that Shareholders read this Explanatory Memorandum before determining whether or not to support the resolutions.

#### **Financial statements and Reports**

The financial report and the reports of the Directors and of the auditor for the financial year ended 31 December 2023 will be laid before the AGM, as required by Section 317 of the Corporations Act. The Corporations Act does not require a vote of Shareholders on these reports.

The Company's 2023 Annual Report (which includes the Directors', auditor's and financial reports) is available on the Company's website:

<u>www.futuregeninvest.com.au</u>. Meeting attendees are invited to direct questions to the Chair in respect of any aspect of the report they wish to discuss.

Representatives of the Company's auditor, Pitcher Partners, will be present for discussion purposes on matters of relevance to the audit.

# Resolution 1 - Adoption of Remuneration Report

The Company's Remuneration Report sets out the remuneration arrangements for the Directors and key management personnel of the Company. The Remuneration Report is part of the Directors' Report contained in the Annual Report of the Company for the financial year ended 31 December 2023.

The Corporations Act requires that at a listed company's AGM, a resolution that the remuneration report be adopted must be put to the shareholders. However, such a resolution is advisory only and does not bind the Directors or the Company. The Board will take the outcome of the vote into account when considering the future remuneration arrangements of the Company.

Shareholders will be given reasonable opportunity at the AGM to ask questions about, and make comments on, the Remuneration Report.

The Directors unanimously recommend that shareholders VOTE IN FAVOUR of Resolution 1.

# **Resolution 2 - Election of Director - Dr Philip Lowe**

#### **BCom Hons PhD**

Dr Philip Lowe has been a Director of the Company since March 2024. Philip was Governor of the Reserve Bank of Australia (RBA) from 2016 to September 2023. He was Chair of the Reserve Bank Board and Payments System Board, and Chair of the Council of Financial Regulators. His career at the RBA spans more than 43 years and he spent two years at the Bank for International Settlements working on financial stability issues. He chaired the Committee on the Global Financial System of the Bank for International Settlements from 2018 to 2023.

Listing Rule 14.4 provides that a director appointed to fill a casual vacancy or as an addition to the board must not hold office (without re-election) past the next annual general meeting of the entity. If Resolution 2 is passed, Dr Lowe will be elected as a director of the Company and if Resolution 2 is not passed, Dr Lowe will cease to be a director of the Company.

The Directors (excluding Dr Lowe) strongly support the election of Dr Lowe and unanimously recommend that shareholders **VOTE IN FAVOUR** of Resolution 2.

# Resolution 3 - Re-election of Director - David Paradice AO

#### BCom FAICD FCA F Fin

David Paradice has been a Director of the Company since April 2015. David Paradice founded Paradice Investment Management in 1999, which has offices in Australia and the USA and invests in equities around the world with approximately \$14.5 billion funds under management. David is a member of the investment committee of the GO Foundation, which provides scholarships to Indigenous students. He is currently the Chairman of the Taronga Foundation. He supports a number of charities across a number of fields including humanitarian, the arts, environmental and education. In 2017, he was awarded an AO for distinguished service to the community through philanthropic contributions and charitable support and to business and commerce in the field of investment management.

Listing Rule 14.4 provides that a director of an entity must not hold office (without re-election) past the third annual general meeting following the director's appointment or 3 years, whichever is longer. If Resolution 3 is passed, Mr Paradice will be reelected as a director of the Company and if



Resolution 3 is not passed, Mr Paradice will cease to be a director of the Company.

The Directors (excluding Mr Paradice) strongly support the re-election of Mr Paradice and unanimously recommend that shareholders **VOTE IN FAVOUR** of Resolution 3.

# Resolution 4 - Re-election of Director - Kate Thorley

#### **BCom CA GAICD**

Kate Thorley has been a Director of the Company since April 2015. Kate Thorley has almost 20 years' experience in the funds management industry and more than 25 years of financial accounting and corporate governance experience. Kate is the Chief Executive Officer of Wilson Asset Management, Director of WAM Capital Limited, WAM Leaders Limited, WAM Research Limited, WAM Active Limited, WAM Microcap Limited, WAM Global Limited, WAM Strategic Value Limited and Future Generation Global Limited.

Listing Rule 14.4 provides that a director of an entity must not hold office (without re-election) past the third annual general meeting following the director's appointment or 3 years, whichever is longer. If Resolution 4 is passed, Ms Thorley will be re-elected as a director of the Company and if Resolution 4 is not passed, Ms Thorley will cease to be a director of the Company.

The Directors (excluding Ms Thorley) strongly support the re-election of Ms Thorley and unanimously recommend that shareholders **VOTE IN FAVOUR** of Resolution 4.


#### Navigation


#### If you would like to cast a vote:




