SUPREME COURT OF NEW SOUTH WALES APPROVES SCHEME OF ARRANGEMENT

APM Human Services International Limited (ASX: APM; 'APM') is pleased to announce that the Supreme Court of New South Wales (**Court**) has today made orders approving the proposed acquisition by Ancora BidCo Pty Ltd, a wholly-owned indirect subsidiary of funds managed and advised by Madison Dearborn Partners, LLC (**MDP**), of all of the shares of APM not already held by MDP or its affiliates, by way of a scheme of arrangement under part 5.1 of the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth) (**Corporations Act**) (**Scheme**).

Unless defined otherwise in this announcement, capitalised terms have the meanings given to them in the scheme booklet dated 16 August 2024.

Lodgement of Court orders and suspension of trading

It is expected that an office copy of the Court orders will be lodged with the Australian Securities and Investments Commission pursuant to section 411(10) of the Corporations Act today, at which time the Scheme will become legally Effective. At the same time, APM will also request that the quotation of all APM Shares on the ASX be suspended from the close of trading today, Wednesday, 25 September 2024.
