COMET RIDGE LIMITED – REQUEST FOR TRADING HALT

Pursuant to ASX Listing Rule 17.1 Comet Ridge Limited (ASX:COI) requests that ASX grant a trading halt of its securities with immediate effect, from prior to commencement of trading Tuesday 10 December 2024 pending the release of an announcement with regard to a proposed capital raising.
