Extension of Defence Base Services Contract

Ventia (ASX:VNT) has signed an extension of the Defence Base Services contract with the Department of Defence for 7-months commencing on 1 July 2025 and ending 31 January 2026. The contracted revenue is approximately \$270 million. The extension sees Ventia continue to provide a range of estate management, living services and base support capability (Firefighting Services contract was awarded to Ventia in July 2024).
