

Federal Court approves agreement between Webjet and ACCC

Webjet Group Limited (**Webjet Group, ASX:WJL**) advises that the Federal Court has today approved the agreement reached with the Australian Consumer and Competition Commission (**ACCC**) in February 2025 to resolve court proceedings against Webjet Marketing Pty Ltd (**Webjet Marketing**), a wholly owned subsidiary of Webjet Group Limited.

In November 2024, the ACCC commenced proceedings against Webjet Marketing in relation to the issuing of booking confirmations and the past disclosure of its fees in social media posts, email marketing and on the Webjet website and mobile application.

As previously disclosed to the ASX, the parties reached agreement over the proceedings in February 2025. The Federal Court's approval formally disposes of the proceeding.

In accordance with the Federal Court's orders, and consistent with the agreement reached between the parties, Webjet Marketing has agreed to:

- pay a total penalty of \$9 million;
- publish a corrective notice in a form agreed with the ACCC for a period of 60 days;
- review, maintain and continue to implement an Australian Consumer Law compliance program in an agreed form; and
- pay a \$100,000 contribution to the ACCC's costs.
