

Project Agreement with Ear Science Institute Australia to Explore Bone Conduction Hearing Solutions

Bone conduction hearing solutions transmit sound through vibrations that travel through the bones in a user's skull, bypassing the eardrum. This allows users to benefit from the audio solution, while keeping their ears open to ambient sounds, offering a different listening experience to traditional headphones.

In addition to ESIA's financial contribution, the project will also benefit from in-kind support from Audeara, including technical expertise, product supply, and project coordination. Both organisations are committed to ensuring the outcomes of the project deliver tangible impact in community settings while informing future development opportunities.

The project is expected to commence this month and will include product evaluation, stakeholder engagement and pilot implementation aimed at improving access to hearing support for children who require assistance hearing in classroom settings.

Both parties recognise the significant potential of bone conduction solutions to deliver positive impact in educational and social participation, while also representing a meaningful commercial opportunity in underserved markets.
