Scheme Meeting approves MaxoTel Scheme of Arrangement

Vonex Limited (ASX: VN8) is pleased to announce that its shareholders have passed, by the requisite majorities, the resolution to approve the proposed acquisition by Maxo Telecommunications Pty Ltd (MaxoTel), of all the shares in Vonex that MaxoTel does not already own, by way of a scheme of arrangement.

In summary:

- 99.6 % of the votes cast by eligible Vonex shareholders were in favour of the scheme resolution; and
- 76.3 % of eligible Vonex shareholders voted in favour of the scheme resolution.

Details of the valid proxies received and the votes cast in respect of the scheme resolution are attached to this announcement.

Next Steps

Vonex has applied to the Supreme Court of New South Wales for approval of the scheme at a hearing scheduled for 9.15am (Sydney time) on Thursday, 9 October 2025.

If the Court approves the scheme at the second court hearing, Vonex intends to lodge a copy of the Court orders with the Australian Securities and Investments Commission on Thursday, 9 October 2025, at which time the scheme will become effective.

If this occurs, Vonex expects that the ASX will suspend Vonex shares from trading on the ASX with effect from close of trading that day.

If the scheme becomes effective, implementation of the scheme is expected to occur on Monday, 20 October 2025 and Vonex shareholders registered on the Vonex share register on the scheme Record Date (being 5.00pm Sydney time on Monday, 13 October 2025) will be entitled to receive the scheme consideration of \$0.036 cash per Vonex share.
