Conditions on the Company's Victorian registrations

Monash IVF Group Limited (ASX:MVF, the "Company") advises that the Victorian Department of Health has determined to impose certain conditions on the registrations of its clinics in Victoria under the *Assisted Reproductive Treatment Act 2008* (Vic) with effect from today, 28 November 2025 ("Conditions").

The Conditions arise following the incident at the Clayton laboratory referred to in the Company's announcement of 10 June 2025 and notification to the Victorian regulator.

The process changes required under the Conditions have already been implemented by the Company through the introduction of enhanced safety protocols following the Company's internal investigation and the Independent McLeod review.

The Conditions include specific actions and obligations relating to the process for confirming the intended biological sources for each cycle; requirements relating to the Company's patient management system, witnessing and checking requirements and record keeping; and staff education and training, periodic auditing and reporting to the Victorian Department of Health.

The Company does not expect that the Conditions will have a material impact on its existing operations, nor does it expect them to have a material impact on the Company's earnings guidance provided to the market on 20 November 2025.

The Company will continue to prioritise the care and safety of its patients and will keep ASX informed of any material developments in accordance with its disclosure obligations.
