

ASX RELEASE (ASX: AHE)**A\$6.1m Holdback Consideration received following ANZ Divestment**

Melbourne, Australia 27 January 2026 – Adheris Health Limited (“Adheris Health” or the “Company”) is pleased to advise that following the sale of the Company’s Australian and New Zealand business unit as announced on 2 July 2025, it has finalised with Jonas Software AUS Pty Ltd the outstanding Holdback portion of the consideration.

As previously outlined, the holdback amount was established to account for any post-completion adjustments arising from the transaction.

Adheris Health confirms that it has now received A\$6.1 million, in addition to the A\$27 million received on the original settlement date. This brings the total consideration received to date to A\$33.1 million.

The transaction also includes a potential “uncapped” earn-out consideration amount, payable over a three-year period, following completion. The first of these potential earn-out payments is due at or around July 2026. Based on information available to-date, early indications suggest that the divested ANZ business continues to perform in line with expectations.
