

Accelerating the Commercial Rollout of ColoSTAT®: 4Cyte Pathology Expands ColoSTAT® Collection Site Network

Highlights

- ✓ Following the successful validation of end-to-end testing workflow and the first commercial sale of its blood based ColoSTAT® colorectal cancer test, Rhythm Biosciences has successfully activated strategic collection centres with 4Cyte Pathology.
- ✓ 4Cyte Pathology has activated an initial network of thirty-eight blood collection sites across major cities in Queensland, New South Wales and Victoria enabling clinician referral and patient access to ColoSTAT® testing through an established clinician pathway at broad scale.
- ✓ Clinicians within designated 4Cyte Pathology clinics are being onboarded to provide referrals for ColoSTAT® testing, with additional collection sites planned as part of the ongoing commercial rollout.
- ✓ Immediate scale-up can now proceed directly with physicians and through the ColoSTAT® Access Program using a validated commercial and logistical pathway.

Melbourne, Australia, 18th March 2026: Rhythm Biosciences Ltd ('RHY', the 'Company' or the 'Group') (ASX: RHY), a transformative, predictive cancer diagnostics technology company is pleased to report the successful activation of its first commercial blood collection network of clinics across major cities enabling the scaling of ColoSTAT® commercial testing services.

Rhythm previously announced the first commercial sale of ColoSTAT® and highlighted the importance of completing the end-to-end logistical and commercial process. Scaling of this process has commenced with the completion by 4Cyte Pathology (4Cyte) of the activation of blood collection sites across Queensland, New South Wales and Victoria, providing clinicians and patients in major metropolitan centres with direct access to the ColoSTAT® test.

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These initial thirty-eight activated sites are in Melbourne, Sydney and Brisbane representing the first phase of Rhythm's broader commercial network rollout strategy with 4Cyte. These sites will be used by members of the ColoSTAT® Access Program as well as physician-directed prescribing of the ColoSTAT® test. Additional collection sites will be activated over the coming weeks.

The partnership with 4Cyte supports and accelerates rapid clinical awareness and promotion of ColoSTAT®, which brings commercial scale through leveraging 4Cyte's existing national pathology network and business development teams that work closely with referring clinicians and medical practices.

Additional sites are currently being activated across the 4Cyte network, with further progress and expansion tracked and reported via 4Cyte's online platform, thereby progressively expanding patient access to the test.

Commenting on the milestone, Rhythm's Managing Director and Chief Executive Officer, Dr David Atkins, said: "The activation of our collection centre network with 4Cyte across Queensland, New South Wales and Victoria marks a pivotal step in ColoSTAT®'s commercial journey. Having a validated, scalable pathway—from blood collection through to result reporting—means we can now focus our energy on building test volumes, both through direct engagement with primary care physicians and our ColoSTAT® Access Program."

Rhythm will provide regular updates on collection network growth and ColoSTAT® test volumes.
