Emyria Activates First Victorian Empax Clinic

First Victorian Empax clinic now officially activated, marking Empax clinic operations across three States.

Key Highlights:

- **Victorian Empax clinic operational, meeting targeted Q2 CY2026 launch date¹** – first treatments have now commenced as forecast.
- **Purpose built 3 bed clinical infrastructure established** - within Avive's Mornington Peninsula Private Hospital¹, option for 4th bed in Q4 CY2026 as demand grows.
- **30+ Victorian therapists recruited and trained², First TGA Approved Authorised Prescriber (AP) confirmed** - with additional AP applications in progress
- **Dual reimbursement pathways available supporting revenue activation** – combined private health insurer (Medibank)³ and government payer (Department of Veterans' Affairs)⁴ funding now available across Western Australia, Queensland and Victoria.

Emyria Limited (ASX: EMD) ("Emyria", or the "Company"), a leader in innovative mental health treatments, is pleased to announce that its Victorian-based Empax clinic is now operational, having successfully commenced first patient treatments.

This milestone meets the Company's Q2 CY2026 clinic activation objective and supports Emyria's strategy to scale reimbursable, evidence-based complex mental health treatments, underpinned by strong and growing clinical evidence⁵.

Victorian Empax Clinic Infrastructure established¹

Emyria has established a dedicated 3 bed clinical infrastructure within Avive Health's Mornington Peninsula Private Hospital, with an option for a 4th bed after 6 months as demand grows.

Key operational workstreams, including site readiness, medication supply and dispensing, regulatory requirements and clinical governance frameworks, are in place supporting a clear pathway to patient throughput.

Clinical Workforce recruitment has been strong

The Company has recruited and trained more than 30 therapists², following a well-supported recruitment campaign.

One trained Psychiatrist has already received TGA approved Authorised Prescriber status with a further three trained and in the AP application process. The clinical workforce and additional AP approvals are expected to support increased utilisation as clinic demand builds.

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Dual reimbursement pathways underpin repeatable revenue model

Reimbursement pathways are active at the clinic for eligible members through a combination of private health insurance (Medibank)³ and government payers (DVA)⁴.

These funded pathways, combined with the strong and expanding clinical evidence base supporting Emyria's treatment models, are expected to support early utilisation rates. Further payers, including Workers Compensation insurers, are expected to bolster utilisation over time.

Executive Chair Greg Hutchinson commented:

"We are pleased to have successfully launched our first Victorian Empax clinic and commenced treatments in line with our Q2 CY2026 target. Importantly, we have established the infrastructure, workforce and funded patient pathways required to support early utilisation and a disciplined ramp-up phase.

With additional Authorised Prescriber applications progressing and referrer engagement underway, we are well positioned to safely scale access to reimbursable, evidence-based mental health treatments supported by strong clinical evidence and a repeatable revenue model".

This release has been approved by the Board of Emyria.
